

Lodge of the Buffalo Bear Heart

Three sources of light came to vision in the painting 'Lodge of the Buffalo Bear Heart'. These light sources are representing the illumination of the three qualities existing within the natural flow of the cosmos, which are the three qualities of which we are made. The closest way to explain these three in a form that might be understood by most is mind, body, and spirit. In the native way, the three qualities encompass far more. In the painting, all three forms represent this universal light showing them in harmonic flow with each other.

The moon is illuminating the silver edges of night while the sun's red glow shows the light of the day and the coming of new visions. Sunset brings the magical timing of balance that exists between night and day. The light of the inner lodge is the illumination of a light that brings these universal qualities together as one.

Heoka spirits, spirits of lightning, are seen as a chief riding a pony across the sky offering with his hand out stretched, the eagle spirit and the thunder of the Buffalo Nations.

A bear spirit sits next to the moon assisting a vision of a strength that can only be found within one's inner circle. Stone Nation people are gathered around the lodge, holding the unchanged way of the four directions.

Ancient symbols are found within the lodge construction. Circles representing the stars and the universe are sitting near the sky and the circles of Earth are painted close to the ground. The lodge poles form an ancient symbol that goes back thousands of the years. They reach far beyond the top creating an unseen, upside down ethereal lodge as they touch the sky. An unseen lodge of the universe spirals its understanding from the Great Mystery to the lower lodge of the earth plain. 'As above as below' is a connection to the cosmos the people never wanted to be far from, and is always spiraling into our world.

The magic of the painting comes alive in the soft glows of these natural forces that carry these powers of the cosmos. We as people can connect to these forces and know we are one with them.

Another ancient symbol came strongly to vision in this painting. This symbol was gifted to me in another vision many years before the painting. Since that time it has accompanied me on a magical journey. That full story is in my book '7 Fires' and is

how the book begins. This ancient symbol is found in the painting as a rock sitting near the water's edge and appears to be similar to three mountain peaks. The rest of the symbol is in the reflection of the water. I discovered this symbol was seven thousand years old at the very least. One of its many understandings is that each peak is representing one of the three sources of light, all from the oneness of the universe.

It was interesting that three months after I had completed the painting, this very obscure symbol appeared as an unseen symbol within a crop circle (starglyph) in England. Its presence sent me on a journey to explain some of the purest and most powerful symbols that exist in our universe. I knew just how obscure this symbol really was and yet it had the teachings of the cosmos pouring into its structure.

This symbol kept magically and serendipitously appearing on my path over a period of years. I designed a bracelet because of this that a friend made for me. That bracelet's design has three of these symbols on each side of a centerpiece of the symbol, polished in special stone.

When the starglyph appeared in the field and I was able to peer into its unseen elements, there was a hidden matrix within three of the symbols designed into its image. It sent me on a road of magic in which I ultimately was able to discover why the pyramids of Egypt were built the way they were. These verifiable discoveries had never been found by Egyptologists or Archeologists since research on the pyramids had begun.

One of the teachings within this symbol is also one of the seven fires in my book '7 Fires'. The seven fires are of the highest teachings in our known universe. They were 7 gifts of truth from the stars and show the higher common thread that exists between all beings throughout the great expanse of the universe. These lost truths exist within all human beings but were long forgotten and disappeared through the wars and material world. I will explain this one in part.
